SUBJECT AREA AND COURSE NUMBER: Art 201

COURSE TITLE: Painting II

CATALOG COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Continuation of Painting I with greater emphasis on developing independent projects and personal objectives.

STUDIO HOURS PER WEEK: Six

PREREQUISITE: Art 200 - Painting I

**COURSE OBJECTIVES:** 

A continuation of Painting I with the emphasis now on the students developing more strongly in independent projects and personal objectives.

## COURSE CONTENT AND SCOPE:

A continuation of Art 200 - Painting Lwith independent personal development in the use of the media the students select for their work. The emphasis is now on student awareness and development of individual ideas. Contemporary ideas and experimenting with new creative media are encouraged through class assignments. Individual development critiques, sometimes involving all the Art Department faculty, will be held with the student. One or two slide lectures will be presented to the class covering several areas of study. The class will make at least one trip to view and discuss gallery works. Art exhibits at C.C.T.C. will be discussed with the class to stimulate ideas and to present to students different styles of contemporary artists.
