Subject Area and Course Number: English 245

Course Title: Major British Writers

Course Catalog Description:

Examination of works by major writers of British literature including Goldsmith, Dickens, Eliot, Thackeray, James and Joyce.

Lecture Hours per week: 3

Credits per course: 3

Prerequisite: English 102

Course Objectives:

- 1. To expose students to the tradition of British literature and to major practitioners of the literary arts.
- 2. To study as many works as is feasible within the course of a semester.
- 3. To analyze the influence and effects of British literature on American culture.

Section II

Course Scope and Content:

- A. Scope: Students read a large number of works written by English and Irish authors. They study these literary samples in order to form judgements as to their worth and influence.
- B. Required Work: A generous selection of readings is assigned.

 There is a midterm and final examination and students write a research paper on an assigned topic.
