GUIDELINES

CAPITAL

- Microgrants awarded to students range from \$50 \$750. Up to \$500 for a first semester student and \$750 for a second semester student. **\$750 maximum during your time here at Capital.**
- Be a currently enrolled student in good academic standing (2.0 GPA and above)
- Students must have Capital as their home campus or be taking at least two courses or 6 credits here.
- Grants do NOT have to be repaid.

Emergency or hardship needs include, but are not limited to:

- Threat of eviction
- Overdue utility bills/turn-off notice
- Medical/Dental bills (not covered by insurance)
- Automobile repairs
- Other (you may explain your emergency in personal statement)

Not Eligible:

- To cover previous college debts or school fees
- To pay a credit-card balance
- This funding is not intended to replace existing financial aid or scholarships
- This grant is not available to international students

Applicants must:

- complete all questions in full on the application and submit supporting documentation.
- Complete the Single Stop Screening to learn about all the entitlement programs and resources for which you and family may be eligible: https://app.singlestop.org/capitalcc/main
- On Financial Avenue, complete two modules: Psychology of Money and Foundations of Money

- Attach any documentation available: medical bill, eviction notice, unemployment notice or similar information that can be verified to support the request (up to \$750).
